It also gives people a greater understanding of major economic issues that confront our nation. Teacher Education"

005-11 "The Center was designated by the National Council on Economic Education to serve as the specialized National Center for Research in Economic Education for its national network of 275 college and university centers for economic education and 50 state councils on economic education. This National Center prepares datasets and conducts studies on the effective teaching and learning of economics."
