Today, I was lead by the holy spirit to read 9-12-9 page of "Our Daily Bread".

It essentially talked about the down side 'competition' in even places that have spiritual responsibilities, and how it is possible that entities are 'jockeying for position in the coming kingdom.' This provides real insight to me as individuals and groups express concerns.

This passage endorsed service as a gateway to leadership and cited Matthew 20:26.

After reading Matthew 20:20-28, and pondering over parts of my spiritual works cv, professional educational cv and diversity cv, I realized that a goal of mine was leadership, but now I believe

→ God is not King if

is in control.

→ "Who is controlling you?"

→ life is more than eating,

consuming (clothes), people

(you don't always have to

have someone with you to

feel complete)

→ don't get so anxious that

it (what to wear, eat)

consumes you.

[it - your clothes - may not be

name brand, but fit

will do the job]

→ these ^{materials} are things that people

who have no relationship

with GOD pursue, seek

→ don't pursue things, but

pursue HIM.

→ then, all those things

that (others) are seeking

will (be provided) to you.

→ it takes effort to (seek God),

- you have to be diligent

(in your pursuit of God).

→ (And, things you were
pursuing) won't matter...

"you get it, and not satisfied,

and the game starts all over again."

- It is an ongoing pursuit
(of the Kingdom of God).

- We must pursue it even
when we don't feel like it

• Has to intention, a mind-set

• History of the Black Pentecostal Church

- Acts 2:1-4

→ The black Pentecostal Church had its beginning in Jerusalem in the upper room

→ The Day of Pentecost - 50 days after Jesus ascended into heaven

- We can receive that same holy spirit that was experienced on the same day of the Day of Pentecost

→ (Gosilatiah?) - we practice

Gosilatiah? (speaking in
tongues)

- ~~The~~ next major movement
didn't occur until the late
1800s - 1900s

→ Carosars? and Quakers
were known to have
(spoke in tongues)

- Holiness teaching is currently
separated from the Pentecostal
doctrine

... William J. Seymour,
a black minister at

the Azusa Street Mission
(Los Angeles, CA) - 1906

- Whites worshipped under
a black preacher at
Azusa Street Mission

→ Women played a prominent
role

→ on the forefront of
having women in ministry

- C.H. Mason, COBIC; Memphis, TN

~~COBIC~~; blended doctrine
of Pentecostal and Holiness;

white pastors under him;

→ White organization formed,

under pressure of white

community; Assemblies of

God (Jimmy Swaggart, James Baker
(cousins of COBIC))

- Fine Baptism - goods
don't matter (be saved,
filled and live a holy life)

→ Bishop B. Johnson
founded Mount Calvary
Holy Church

→ died right after preaching

→ Bishop H. I. Williams
became Senior Bishop -
(married to Shirley Cesar)

→ A. A. Owens merged ~~with~~
(Christ is the Answer Chapel
with Mount Calvary)

• Led to GMCA C.

Now Arch. Bishop
of Mt Calvary Churches
world-wide
